
How Did the 5K Challenge Get Started?

It all started because
 we've been using a
 unique application of a
 simple yet active options
 strategy to generate
 \$200 to \$300 per week
 using a small amount of
 capital...

Where Did the Idea Come From?

- In 2015 started using multiple tickers in my main trading account
- A strategy that managed both long and short positions
- Tested this strategy for several years to get it right
- "The Option Trade That Keeps On Giving"



"The Big Idea"

- Set aside a part of our portfolio to aggressively trade the 5K Challenge
- To "scale it up" to 10 to 20 contracts each with 5 to 10 tickers
- See if we could generate
 \$5,000 of income per week
 from those positions

Never Gave Up the Big Idea

- Shared the idea with John and Dave at Traders Reserve who put up the "Challenge" to see if we could to it
- Mostly based on the tactics we've been teaching and trading in Small Account Trader



The 5K Challenge

Reduced the goal to \$5,000
 a week to control risks and see if it was achievable with a separate \$100,000 account





The 5K Challenge Goal

- Dedicate a "subset portfolio" of \$100,000 to an "Aggressive Trading Strategy"
- Generate \$5,000 per week of net income
- Manage active option selling strategies to achieve goal
- Control Risk
- Limit Drawdowns
- Rapid Compounding
- Trade 3 to 5 times per week



Why Did We Believe We Could Achieve These Results?

- Results from the Small
 Account Trader Workshop and
 Small Account Trader PRO
 Service
- Real time trades made from live trading sessions
- Averages ... some weeks higher or lower
- A few of the underlying tickers that work for this approach


5K Challenge started as a "Beta Test" ...


- We knew there could be wide swings week-to-week
- Putting \$60,000 to \$80,000 of capital at risk each week
- Quick action for trade adjustments (little time for email alerts)
- Work out the bugs and kinks and firm up the rules



Setting Up the Test

- Opened a Dedicated Trading Account
- TD Ameritrade (ThinkorSwim)
- \$100,000 of cash
- Tax Deferred IRA





5K Challenge Assumptions: \$100k Account

- Active Capital of \$80,000
- Number of positions: 5 to 7
- Capital per position: \$8,000 to \$20,000
- Average capital per 1 contract per position: \$3,000
- Contracts per position: 2 to 20
- Include Trading Fees in the results

"5K / Week" Basics

- Liquid Tickers: SPY, QQQ, DIA, IWM, SMH, XBI, XOP, etc.
- Directional bias: Neutral, bullish or bearish
- Calls or Puts or a combination of Calls or Puts
- Spread trades with long option 30 to 120 days out and short option 5 to 10 days out
- Enter calendar/diagonal trades as a net debit and exit with a credit
- Close and open trades as needed
- Manage the short position week-to-week

Beta Test Time Frame

- Trading Strategy Started Today (11/18/21)
- Trade Set-ups, Trades and filled-out first 5 positions by (11/28)
- 14 weeks of trading
- Update results at the Investor's Blueprint Live Training and Trading Event




Key Numbers

- Ticker prices ranged from \$90 to \$4,500
- Contracts from 2 to 20
- Maximum capital invested at anyone time: \$93,230 (3 days)
- Average capital invested during the entire time: \$78,768



The 5K Challenge Experience

- Chris and Dave getting together virtually to trade 2X to 6X per week
- Neutral to bullish/bearish assumptions
- Reviewing "risk profile" charts
- Analyzing entry and exit points



Trade Management

This was NOT a "static" option strategy

Managed trade positions several times a week

Trades were managed more actively to achieve returns

Trade positions were defended with advanced options trading strategies to reach our goal

Stretched to exceed goal each week to protect against market moves against our positions

Our Trade Adjustments

- Typically, we bought another calendar or diagonal at a different strike price
- Forced at several times to close one side at a loss
- If we had early profits ... we took them
- Most trades were started on Thursday and Friday and reset every Thursday or Friday
- Adjustments and rolls were on Tuesday or Wednesday

Beta Test Closed Trade Profit Results

- Weekly Profit Avg: \$4,495.00
- Primarily calendar/diagonal spread trades
- Forced to open/close trades (Re-Set) almost weekly
- Had to drop QQQ as tech stocks sold-off in January 2022

5K Challenge Test Launch: Alpha Group

Started with the same \$100K in our Test Account





Launched Alpha Test April 2022

- Accepted 25 members to measure and control liquidity issues (Alpha Group)
- Re-Set 5K Challenge Portfolio to \$100,000 of capital
- (Master Portfolio account IRA)
- Trade alerts sent only via dedicated 5K Challenge App (no email)
- Live Review Sessions

Stock Market During Alpha Roll-Out

- Down Trending Market
- Continued sell-off in tech and internet stocks
- Volatile market
- "Sell the News"
- Extreme down-draft days
- Panic selling Jun 9 17

2nd Qtr. (2022) Closed Trade Results (Alpha)

- Up 43% through first 8 weeks
- \$5,430 per week average of cash profits thru 5 weeks
- Trading slowed in early June
- Intra-day market reversals hit positions in mid-June
- Trade Re-sets were not enough
- 2 weeks (6/18 and 6/25) took big losses in 2 energy positions

New Charlie Group Members (July 2022)



Accepted Another 21 New Members July 2022

- Accepting "experience" option spread traders
- Manage and measure trading volume impact
- Continue refining and improving tactics
- Trading in a difficult market environment
- Labeled them the "CHARLIE" Group





Last 3 Months of Trading



- Bear Market Rally
- Followed by extreme selling
- Continued news driven price action
- Change in tactics to meet market conditions


- Struggled to match 5K Challenge goals with "whipsaw" market
- Began to change trading tactics to meet bearish market conditions
- Shift to smaller wins and profits
- Directional bias and shorter DTE's
- Testing new underlying tickers for inclusion

Change in Trading Environment in the Last Year

- Technical trading to news driven trading
- 11 years of cheap money ...
- Many stocks overvalued
- Traditional Trading #s out of "Wack": VIX, Treasury Yields,
- Stocks down, bonds down



Our Key Goals for Managing 5K: The Greeks

Maximum Weekly **Theta** Decay ... \$1,500 to \$4,000 per day

Delta neutral to slightly biased if we have a bias

Gamma usually negative

Vega positive

Challenges to Managing Theta Decay ("The Option Crush")

Beta Test and Alpha ... would carry \$2,000 to \$4,000 theta decay into Thursday/Friday

Boosted profits waiting those extra days

Changed in June as intra-week reversals hit hard

- S&P 500 Performance this year by day of the week:
- Monday -8.77%
- Tuesday -3.81%
- Wednesday +8.00%
- Thursday -10.26%
- Friday -9.46%

5K Challenge Factors During the First Year

Positives:

- Traded out of tech sell-off in 1st Qtr.
- Rapid Trade Re-Sets on Calendars/Diagonals generated outsized profits
- Benefited from rising energy prices
- Neutral bias generally paid off
- Large cap strength


Challenges:

- News driven market price action (whipsaw trading)
- Intra-day price reversals
- Harder to rely on predictable indicators
- Whipsaws in the market direction day-to-day
- Support and resistance levels violated

Last 3 Weeks of 5K Challenge Trading

- Producing more consistent profits
- Taking profits earlier
- Smaller wins
- Avoiding managing or closing trades on Friday's
- Broken wing butterflies and semi-directional tactics






5K Challenge Program Today

- Expanding tactics besides core (calendar/diagonal trades)
- Short duration BWBs
- And longer duration trades to get wider
- Semi-directional bias
- Wild swings as sell points
- Live Testing a tactic that can handle swings in volatility
- Targeting 5% to 10% per week

5K Challenge Master Portfolio Results



- First 11 Months:
- Master Portfolio Gains in 10 months: \$10,341.20
- Master Portfolio Gains in 2022: \$3,740.63

5K Challenge Trading

- On a \$100,000 account, keep 20k in cash for adjustments
- Low commissions, there is a lot of trading involved and commissions are a factor
- SPX and RUT are higher risk, closer watching, tighter adjustments but lower commissions
- Need level 4-6 options trading permission (spreads, margin, indexes, cash secured put selling, ratios)
- Can be done in an IRA if the account is approved for that level of trading
